**Registration Details**

For returning families, NEW 2020 information is highlighted in yellow. Please read carefully!!

*Basic Program Information . . .*

- ASP will start on **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020.**
  - It is held Mondays/Thursdays (for students in the GREEN group for school) and Tuesday/Fridays (for students in the GOLD group for school).
  - The program is held on school days between dismissal time and 6:00pm.
  - If in-person learning resumes to full time, we will reassess the program offerings.
  - Students will be required to pay for two days of the program:
    - Students in the GREEN group for school, can attend the After School Program on MONDAYS and THURSDAYS.
    - Students in the GOLD group for school, can attend the After School Program on TUESDAYS and FRIDAYS.
- \*\*You will be charged for both days regardless if your child attends the program or not.**
- The program is based in the North Collins Elementary School Cafeteria and Art Room (outdoor access to ball fields and playgrounds will be maximized when safely available)
  - There is NO ASP on holidays, half days, **virtual learning days**, or days school is closed/released early due to weather or other instances
  - Students must be in Kindergarten-6<sup>th</sup> Grade and attend North Collins Elementary School to take part in the ASP
  - Any change to your child's attendance must be done by phone call or note by 11:00am the day of. The only acceptable changes will be that your child is NOT attending the program (instead that he/she is taking the bus home or being picked up by a parent/guardian at school dismissal time). **Please note that you will still be charged as if your child is attending.**
  - All ASP students will be escorted to their vehicle by a Counselor when a parent/guardian arrives to pick them up. **Once parked in the front circle of the Elementary School (off of Bantle Road), parents/guardians should call 716-337-0166, ext. 2315.** Signs will be visible on the sidewalk with the phone number when you pull up.
  - Changes to pick up individuals must be made in advance by phone call or note. Everyone should be prepared to show ID if asked.

- All Recreation Accounts must be current and remain in good standing in order to participate.

### *Registration . . .*

- Students must be registered in order to attend the ASP
- **In order to attend the program the first week of school, students must be registered by 9/4/2020.** Late registrants may be subject to a waiting period in order to process their placement.
- **A maximum of 30 students** will be accepted into the program in order to adhere to health and safety guidelines. Registration will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- The cost to attend is \$6/day/child.
