

THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF NORTH COLLINS WAS HELD ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 11, 2014, AT 7:00PM IN THE NORTH COLLINS TOWN HALL, 10569 MAIN STREET, NORTH COLLINS, NEW YORK.

Item 1. Deputy Supervisor Perry called the meeting to order at 7:12pm and led the Pledge to the Flag at the request of the Supervisor.

Item 2. Mr. Tobia introduced Grant Writer Bernie Rotella, who explained his services. He would work with the Town's capital projects list, and charge \$1200 per month on a retainer. He suggested that the Town and Village join in hiring him.

Item 3. **MINUTES.** Ms. Ricotta moved to approve the May Minutes as previously presented. Second: Mathis

Item 4. HEARING OF VISITORS

- 2) Greg Bonnes thanked the Town Board for the excellent condition of the Fricano Park shelter that he recently reserved.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Item 5. **RECREATION REPORT.** Recreation Director Jan Mathis reported on Day Camp and other current programs. He requested:
BE IT RESOLVED that Recreation Director Jan Mathis is authorized to purchase recreation equipment in the amount of \$908.92. Moved: Tobia. Second: Ricotta.

Item 7. **PARKS.** Susan Alessi reported that the Community Garden bins are all planted and the committee is grateful for the assistance of the Highway Department. There was a discussion about striping the ballfields and it was decided to continue as is for this season.

Item 8. **HISTORIAN.** Mrs. Bowman submitted her report and spoke of recent activity. She invited all to the Chicken Barbecue and special speaker on June 29. at the Quaker

Meeting House. Christopher Densmore will speak on the Quakers in the area. She requested:

Item 9. **LIBRARY.** Mrs. Alessi reported on summer programs at the Library. Legislator John Mills will hold his Hot Dog fundraiser there on July 2. The 2013 Annual Library Report has been submitted to the Town Clerk.

Item 10. **SUPERVISOR'S REPORT.** Mrs. Seege requested and moved:

BE IT RESOLVED that \$60,000 be transferred from Highway Equipment Reserve to DA8686.2 to pay for the Highway Department tractor in 2013. as requested by Auditing Firm FreedMaxick. Second: Tobia.

Mrs. Seege stated that a corrected AUD will be filed.

Item 11. **RECREATION PETTY CASH.** Mr. Mathis requested:

Item 12. Mr. Tobia attended the School Board meeting. He has received a notice from State Senator Gallivan regarding new funding for the School Resource Officer, and presented it to the School Board. The School has refused to distribute the Planning Board surveys through the students.

Item 13. Mrs. Ricotta

1) Attended the Village Board meeting and is working with the Village Clerk to provide a 'Welcome Package' for new residents.

2) She reported that Justice Stevens has requested that the outside court door be replaced and the rug cleaned after the recent flooding. The Court has signed a new contract with their law book company for online updates which will save the Town a lot of money.

3) Dog Control Officer reported 8 calls during the month.

4) Assessor Ebersole requested:

BE IT RESOLVED that Jill Collins is hereby appointed the **Board of Assessment Review** to fill the vacancy of Mary Ann Gabel, who resigned, until 9/30/2018. Moved: Ricotta.

5) Regarding the April payment to the State for Assessment software, Assessor Ebersole found that an overpayment was made and she will attempt to obtain a credit from the State ORPS.

Item 14. Mr. Perry has requested quotes for replacing the Courtroom door and the sump pump and painting the Historical Building trim. Electrical work has been completed at Helmuth following recent flooding issues. Extermination has been completed at the Library and pavilion, as well as at Fricano Park.

Item 15. Mrs. Mathis stated that she would act as liaison for the Town's website, to contact organizations for their input.

The proposed **Helmuth Contract** for takeover of lead agency has been received from the Seneca Nation.

Item 18. **TOWN CLERK REPORT.** 1) Mrs. Orrange has received notice of Cancellation of Workmen’s Comp insurance from Modern Disposal. She will pursue.

2) A letter from Lynn Wightman praised the Town for the excellent condition of the **Marshfield Cemetery** on Memorial Day. The Highway Department is now maintaining the cemeteries.

3) From **North Collins Central School**, notice of School Board election results, as per law.

4) **Town Clerk Monthly Report for May 2014** to the Supervisor with a check for \$694.92.

5) Letter from the **State DOT** that they are studying the Town’s request for a reduced speed limit **on Larkin Road.**
